

# Canada's 150th and St. George's 225th Anniversary

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## Clock Repair Project

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Parishioners, visitors and Kingstonians have approached us hoping to see our wonderful clock running again.

### **RETROFIT DETAILS**

**Install a new 4 Way Clock Movement:** A new heavy duty and maintenance free base mounted central drive with steel frame. **Clock Control:** A fully automatic electronic unit to maintain the clock movement; automatically adjust for daylight savings time and long life lithium battery backup for auto time correction after power outages.

Included in this retrofit is the addition of a **Digital Speaker Bell Sound/Westminster Hour-Striking sound system**. This provides for hourly, and if desired, half hour and/or quarter hour strikes. It also offers various other bell calls such as call to worship, hymns and melodies. For our neighbours, the clock would not strike from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. How we set up the clock to peal is still to be decided.

This project has an estimated cost of \$16,000 including electrical.

How would we fund this? The Executive sees this as an opportunity for the Parish to support the cost through individual donations in conjunction with funds from the Capital Reserve.

**We believe this is a worthy Canadian Sesquicentennial Project which also recognizes St. George's 225th Anniversary.**
