**Rededication of the clock and carillon and the Stuart Room.**

*At the time of the offerings of the people, the Wardens shall come forward and present as special offerings, the clock and carillon and the Stuart Room in these or similar words.*

*Wardens:* We present to you this clock and carillon, originally dedicated to the Glory of God and in grateful thanksgiving for those who served in the Armed Forces in the first and second World Wars, and now renovated as a gift of thanksgiving for the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Canadian Confederation, and the 225<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of St. George's parish. We also present the renovated Stuart Room to be set apart once again for the service of Christ's Holy Church.

*The following versicles shall be said:*

*Celebrant:* All things come from you, O Lord;  
*People:* **And from your own gifts do we give to you.**  
*Celebrant:* Prosper the work of our hands;  
*People:* **Prosper our handiwork.**  
*Celebrant:* Show your servants your works;  
*People:* **And your splendor to their children.**

*Celebrant:* Let us pray.

Almighty God, we thank you that you have put it into the hearts of your people to make offerings for your service, and have been pleased to accept their gifts. Be with us now and bless us as we set apart this room and this carillon and clock to your praise and glory in honour of those who served in the forces during the two great wars, and in thanksgiving for the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Canadian Confederation,

and the 225<sup>th</sup> anniversary of St. George's Parish; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

*People:* **Amen.**

**Dedication of the Clock and Carillon**

*A Verger may then lead the Wardens and Celebrant to the King St. Entrance.*

*Celebrant:* Their sound has gone out into all lands, and their message to the ends of the world.

*Celebrant* I call to you, my people;  
*People:* **My voice is to the children of God.**

*Celebrant:* O God, accept our offering of this carillon, which we consecrate today: Grant that in this generation and in those to come, its voice may continually call your people to praise and worship; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

*People:* **Amen.**

*At this time, the Bells shall be pealed.*

**Dedication of the Stuart Room**

*The Verger will then lead the Wardens and Celebrant to the Entrance to the Stuart Room.*

*Celebrant:* God of mercy and truth, you sent your Son to be our Saviour and Lord. He calls us together as his church to carry on the work of salvation. We ask you now to continue to bless us, and all those who will use this space. May all who come here know the presence of Christ, experience the joy of his friendship, and grow in his love. Grant this through Christ our Lord.

*People:* **Amen.**

## **A Thanksgiving for the work of the Projects Group.**

*A Verger will then lead the Wardens and Celebrant back to the Chancel Steps. Members of the Projects Group are asked to stand. The Celebrant may take an opportunity to make mention of the very generous gifts of the Projects group toward these two endeavours and their long-term faithfulness in assisting with other important developments to the life of the congregation.*

*Celebrant:* We bless your Name, O Lord, because it has pleased you to enable these, your servants, through their work, to offer gifts for your worship and the good of this community. Remember them for good, and grant that all who benefit from their work may show their thankfulness to you by entering into this place in accordance with your will; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

*People:* **Amen.**

*The Verger and Wardens shall return to their places and the Eucharist continues with the Eucharistic prayer.*
