Communion Rails: Return of the Communion Rail at the Nave Altar: This week sees the return of the communion rail after a 3 year absence. A few reminders about taking communion at the rail: Communicants can stand or kneel. There is a natural split to right and left where the gates meet in the middle. Please take the kneelers from the outside into the middle. The choir will be communicating at the high altar; the children will take communion at the rail before the main congregation.
